


# CITY OF HONDO & ALAMO 1 Residential Recycling Program

The City of Hondo and ACI Recycling and Disposal/Alamo 1 are pleased to be offering a city-wide residential recycling program beginning **July 22, 2010**.

Please call the Hondo City Hall at 830-426-3378 and ask to be put on the pickup list. Let's go green to keep our City clean!

City-wide residential recycling will be offered on every fourth (4<sup>th</sup>) Thursday of the month. Customers must provide their own container, preferably with a lid. Containers must be at your usual garbage collection area by 6:00am on recycling day. Please mark your container with the word "RECYCLE."

## **Recyclable Items:**

- ✓ **Paper:** Most types of paper are recyclable, such as ad circulars, catalogs, carbonless paper, dry goods packaging with liners removed (for example: cereal, pasta, rice, beer/soda cartons), envelopes, file folders, flattened cardboard, junk mail, magazines, newspapers, office paper, paperback books, paper bags, paper towel/toilet paper cores, phone books, and non-metallic gift wrap.
- ✓ **Plastics:** Must be labeled #1 through #7. Look for the recycling symbol  on the bottom. Remove lids and rinse all food or liquids. Examples include: beverage bottles, shampoo and lotion bottles, meat trays, condiment bottles, prescription and medicine bottles.
- ✓ **Glass Bottles and Jars (All Colors):** Examples include beverage bottles, food and condiment bottles, and jars. Make sure to remove lids and rinse all food or liquids.
- ✓ **Metal Cans:** Aluminum, steel, and tin beverage and food cans, aerosol cans, and baking tins for example. Make sure to rinse and remove all food or liquids and empty and remove nozzle on aerosol cans.

## **Non-Recyclable Items:**

- Auto parts and motor oil containers
- Brush
- Bagged leaves
- Batteries
- Coat hangers
- Diapers
- Facial tissue and toilet paper
- Food and wet waste
- Household Hazardous Waste
- Plastic bags
- Plastic utensils
- Plastic packaging
- Packing peanuts
- Paper towels
- Shredded paper
- Syringes or medical items
- Water hoses
- Wax-coated paper drink containers
