

Did You Know?

The City of Hondo will pay the sum of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) to any person or persons who provide information that leads to the conviction of any person(s) who engages in any act of illegal dumping on private or public property and city rights-of-way.

Ordinance number 806-04-04, **Throwing of Trash, Etc., Unlawful**, states that: It shall be unlawful for any person to throw, to leave, or place, or caused to be placed, any garbage or refuse, litter, rubbish, solid or liquid wastes, hazardous substances, sewage, body waste, trash, paper, sweepings, cans, glass, fluid, water, or any material or thing on any premises within the corporate limits of the City of Hondo. Brush piles also may be considered as illegal dumping if criteria of this ordinance are met. Violators of this ordinance shall be fined up to a maximum of \$2,000 for each offense.

Illegal dumping constitutes a nuisance, it endangers the health, safety and welfare of city residents and it detracts from the aesthetic appearance of our community. Together we can make a difference and keep our community clean. We ask that you please notify the Hondo Police Department at 426-5353 or the Code Compliance Office at 426-4737 to report any illegal dumping violations.
