

### **Did You Know?**

Of all code violations, high grass and weeds are the most recurring problem throughout Texas cities. Although we are still considered to be in a drought, the recent rain from a couple of weeks ago was enough for grass and weeds to grow rapidly. The City of Hondo is asking residents to take the time to trim and mow their property if weeds and grass have exceeded ten inches (10').

As a reminder, Hondo Code of Ordinance, Chapter 6, Article 6.1400, Section 6.1403, states that it shall be unlawful for any person who is an owner of premises to allow weeds, rubbish, brush or any other unsightly, objectionable or unsanitary matter to accumulate or grow on said property, or to allow, suffer or permit grass or weeds growing in a height greater than ten inches (10') to remain on such real property, thereby creating a fire and/or safety hazard, and/or health risk, including the risk of rodent and insect infestation.

High grass and weeds detract from the aesthetic appearance of our community. Together we can make a difference and keep our community clean. We ask that you please notify City of Hondo, Code Compliance Office at 830-426-4737 if you have any questions.
